


MARIA JOSE BENVENUTO



View from the balcony 4, 2022 Acrylic on canvas 150 x 150 cm













Green View, 2020 Acrylic on linen 120 x 120 cm






Australian Foliage 4, 2022 Acrylic on canvas 120 x 90 cm






Australian Foliage 3, 2022 Acrylic on canvas 120 x 90 cm






Australian Foliage, 2022 Acrylic on canvas 120 x 90 cm






Australian Foliage 6, 2022 Acrylic on canvas 150 x 150 cm
